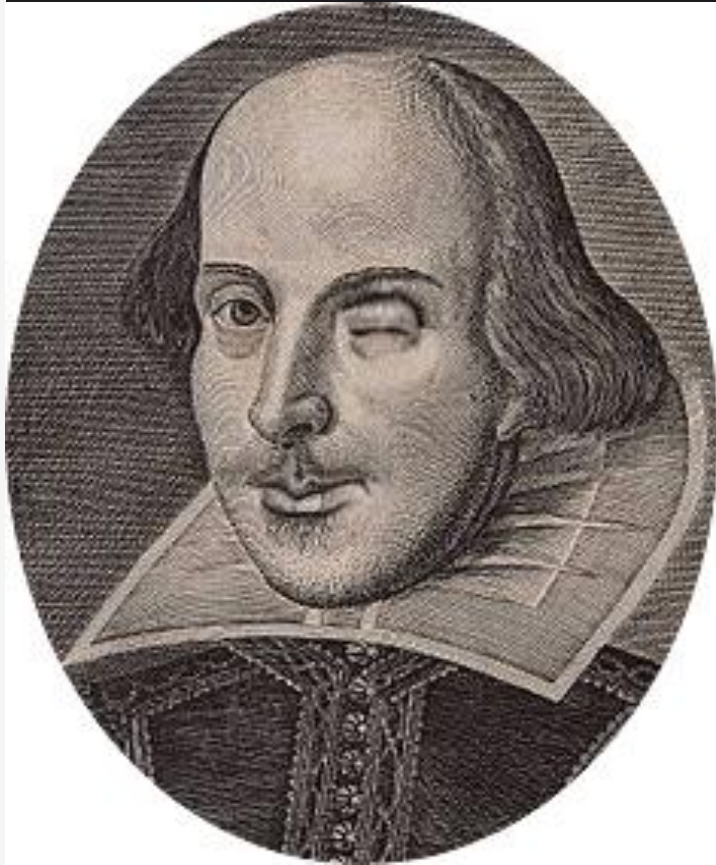



SHAKESPEARE




Biography

Shakespeare was born in Stratford-upon-Avon in 1564. He was the son of John Shakespeare and Mary Arden. He had three brothers and three sons. Shakespeare was an English poet, playwright, and actor, widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language. He is often called England's national poet. His works, including collaborations, consist of approximately 38 plays, 154 sonnets, and 2 long narrative poems. Shakespeare produced most of his known work between 1589 and 1613. His plays remain highly popular, and are constantly studied, performed, and reinterpreted in different cultural and political contexts throughout the world. He died in 1616.

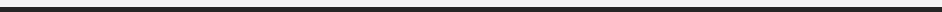
